



## MOLECULAR MICROBIOLOGY ICD-9 CODES - MEDICARE & ALL INSURANCES

Medicare has established the following limited coverage for Chlamydia trachomatis (87491)/Neisseria gonorrhoeae (87591) and BD Affirm VPIII (87480, 87510, 87660). C. trachomatis/N. gonorrhoeae and BD Affirm VPIII test(s) will only be covered by Medicare when it is ordered due to the following conditions. An approved ICD-9 code(s) from the following list must be provided on the requisition form for Medicare.

If the testing is ordered in the absence of any of the following conditions, please check off the screening ICD-9 code (V74.5) provided on the PCNM requisition. Also, if the patient's primary insurance is Medicare and the only ICD-9 code that can be provided is the V74.5 code, the patient must sign an ABN form indicating that she/he understands that Medicare may not pay for the test. If one of the ICD-9 codes from this list is provided, the screening ICD-9 code (V74.5) is not needed.

Human papillomavirus (HPV) testing will only be covered by Medicare when it is ordered due to the following conditions. An appropriate ICD-9 code from the following list must be provided on the requisition form for Medicare.



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If the testing is ordered in the absence of any of the following conditions, please check off the screening ICD-9 code (V73.81) provided on the PCNM requisition. Also, if the patient's primary insurance is Medicare and the only ICD-9 code that can be provided is the V73.81 code, the patient must sign an ABN form indicating that she/he understands that Medicare may not pay for the test. If one of these ICD-9 codes from this list is provided, the screening ICD-9 code (V73.81) is not needed.
